Samsung C&T to build new landmark skyscraper in Malaysia

Samsung C&T, the construction and trading arm of Samsung Group, said Wednesday that it has bagged a contract to construct Star Development in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, by Alpine Return Sdn Bhd, a joint venture between United Malayan Land Bhd and Symphony Life Bhd.

The \$310 million project will involve constructing three high-rise towers and a boulevard accommodating restaurants and an entertainment hub. It will also feature Malaysia's first and only Star Walk of Fame — a 200 meter-long stretch dedicated to both local and international celebrities that is similar to Hollywood's Walk of Fame.

"We look forward to continuing our support for Malaysia's growth and development," said Samsung C&T CEO Choi Chi-hun. "We are certain that despite the challenges, the project will be successful."

The \$310m project comprises construction of three high-rise towers, including a 57-floor, 251m-high tower and two 58-floor, 265m-high residential towers.

Star Development is planned to be built in the central business area in Kuala Lumpur in the vicinity of the Petronas Twin Towers

Samsung C&T has started work on the Star Development in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The US\$ 310 million project for Alpine Return, a joint venture between United Malayan Land and Symphony Life, will comprise residential, shopping and entertainment facilities in a complex including three 250 m+ towers.

Once completed, the single 57-floor, 251 m tower and two 58-floor, 265 m towers will be among the tallest residential structures in the company. They will be built in Kuala Lumpur's business district, near the Petronas Towers, which Samsung C&T was also involved in building.

Samsung C&T president & CEO Chi Hun Choi said, "We are honored to be part of the Star Development project. We look forward to continuing our support for Malaysia's growth and development, having participated in large scale projects including Petronas Twin Towers. Though challenging, we are certain that by working closely together with


our trusted partners and maintaining a strong emphasis on safety, the project will be successful."

Samsung C&T has won a \$310m contract from Alpine Return, a joint venture between United Malayan Land and Symphony Life, to build the Star Development tower complex in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

The complex will house Star Residences including luxurious residential homes, as well as Star Boulevard which is a retail and entertainment hub.

Star Residences will be located within Kuala Lumpur's central business area.

Under the contract, the company will build three high-rise towers, including a 251m high tower spanning 57 levels, and two 58-storey, 265m high luxurious residential towers.

The structures are touted to be one of the tallest residential towers in Kuala Lumpur following the completion of construction.

At the same time, the complex will comprise Malaysia's first and only Star Walk of Fame, which is a 200m long stretch featuring local as well as international celebrities.

Construction has already commenced on 7 November, with completion scheduled by 2019.

지난 1999년 말레이시아 페트로나스 트윈타워를 건설했던 삼성물산이 다시 말레이시아 초고층 랜드마크를 짓는다.

삼성물산은 18일 저녁 말레이시아 스타 레지던스(Star Residences)빌딩의 공식 기공식과 함께 스타 레지던스 빌딩의 시공사로 참여한다고 19일 밝혔다.

스타 레지던스 빌딩은 말레이시아 수도 쿠알라움푸르 중심부에 265m 58층 2개동과 251m 57층 1개동 총 3개동의 초고층 주상복합빌딩으로 오는 2019년 8월 공사가 완료되면 말레이시아 주거시설로는 최 고층이다. 삼성물산은 이번 공사를 단독으로 수행할 예정이며, 공사금액은 3300억원이다.

이번 프로젝트는 말레이시아 민간개발업체인 UM Land와 심포니라이프(Symphony Life)가 각각 50%의 지분으로 참여한 특수목적법인(SPC) 알파인 리턴(Alpine Return)이 발주처로 삼성물산은 시공부분에 참여한다.

지난 18일 저녁 말레이시아 스타 레지던스 현장에서 열린 기공식에는 다툭 닥터 옹 홍 펭(Y,BHG, DATUK DR, ONG HONG PENG) 말레이시아 관광문화부 차관과 탄 스리 아즈만 야햐(Tan Sri Azman Yahya) 알파인 리턴 회장 겸 심포니라이프 회장, 삼성물산 최치훈 사장이 참석했다. 특히 말레이시아 출신의 세계적인 디자이너 지미추(Jimmy Choo) 등 말레이시아 유명 인사들이 참석해 이번 프로젝트의 높은 관심을 나타냈다.

이번 수주 역시 고객신뢰를 바탕으로 발주처가 먼저 사업 참여를 요청해 삼성물산이 단독으로 참여한 프로젝트라는 점이 눈에 띈다. 실제 페트로나스 트윈타워가 완공된 지 15년이 지난 지금에도 삼성물산 은 말레이시아 국민들에게 말레이시아의 상징인 페트로나스의 시공사로 잘 알려져 있다.

실제 발주처인 알파인 리턴은 사업초기 당시 말레이시아 최고급 레지던스의 상징성, 짧은 공사기간의 한계, 초고층빌딩 공사수행역량을 이번 사업의 중점관리사항으로 정하고 먼저 삼성물산에 사업수행 검토를 의뢰한 것으로 알려졌다.

한편 삼성물산은 지난 1999년 당시 세계 최고층인 452m 페트로나스를 시공해 초고층 공사수행역량을 전 세계에 알렸으며, 이후 2010년 828m 163층, 현존 세계 최고층 건축물인 UAE 부르즈 칼리파(Burj Khalifa)를 완공한 바 있다.

이 건물은 수도 쿠알라룸푸르 중심부에 들어서는 초고층 주상복합 빌딩이다. 58층(265m) 2개동과 57층 (251m) 1개동 총 3개동 규모다. 공사금액은 3300억원, 오는 2019년 8월 준공 예정이다.

삼성물산 최치훈 사장은 "이번 프로젝트는 페트로나스 트윈타워와 함께 말레이지아 시장에 새로운 역사를 쓰는 사업이 될 것"이라며 "성공적으로 공사를 수행해 발주처의 가치를 한 층 높일 계획"이라고 말했다.
